This is the 51st Scientific Conference of the Canadian Federation of Biological Societies (CFBS). The scientific program discusses two themes 1) Nano Structures & their Biomedical Applications 2). Metabolomics, Technologies & Applications. The Scientific Exhibits will be held on Wednesday & Thursday, June 20 & 21, 2007. The Nano Structure theme is to follow the Nanoforum meeting organized by NRC & NSERC which will conclude mid day through Wednesday, June 20, 2007. Delegates from the Nanoforum will be given free access and will be encouraged to come and visit the Exhibits.
